

Life Group Notes 20th September 2020

The Son of Man and Son of God

Jesus is the Son of God, the eternal begotten Son who is fully God. He is also the Son of Man, fulfilment of Daniel's prophecy, representative of Israel and fully compassionate of human frailty. This made Him the only one who could have reached us in our sin and brought us into right relationship with God.

What did God speak to you about on Sunday? What can you remember from Owen's message?

The Son of Man in scripture speaks of God's people, with Jesus being the ultimate representative, being crushed by the beast but then exalted to the right hand of power. What ways does God show this pattern through His word?

Start by looking at:

- Daniel 6
- Genesis 38-44

Can you find any more examples? [Isaiah 53:5]

What does this mean for our lives in reflection of Jesus being our representative but also for us who are In Christ? [Colossians 3]

Read Matthew 14:23-33

Jesus is seen through these verses to be the Lord of the wind and the waves. His divinity is shown through his command over nature and it reveals to the disciples who He is. ***Think back to the first time Jesus revealed himself to you, how did it make you feel?***

The disciples are said to be in awe and fear in this passage and also in the corroborating stories in Mark and Luke. ***Can you give an example of when you experienced the awe and fear of God in your daily life?***

On Sunday, Owen finished speaking about the excitement of Christ being the only way to God, because of his humanity and divinity. ***How can we show our excitement of our salvation in our daily lives to our friends/neighbours/colleagues?***

Finally read Colossians 1:15-20, reflect and pray on the incredible act of the incarnation, Jesus' character and of our salvation into His kingdom and family.

Book that we are recommending people read alongside the bible this series is, **The Incomparable Christ by J. Oswald Sanders.**
