The amazing miracles of Jesus

What did God speak to you about on Sunday? What can you remember from Anna's message?

During his ministry Jesus performed many miracles, signs and wonders, these miracles showed that Jesus is God, the Messiah who came to earth to save us and give us life eternal and life in all its fullness now. The amazing promise of Jesus is that when 'we ask in His name we will do greater works than these'. As believers we are called to grow in faith and pray for healings and miracles.

Look up Isaiah 35v5-6, Isaiah prophesied this about Jesus 750 years before Jesus ministry on earth. Depending on the dynamics of your group either get each person or household to look up the following passages relating to each miraculous event and discuss/ reflect upon the following questions or choose John 9 and discuss together as a group:-

- *What happened?*
- *What did Jesus say ?*
- *What was the effect in the crowd/community/disciples of this healing?*
- *If relevant- What did those around say? Did everyone agree? Did everyone like the fact Jesus had healed that person/s?*
- *What strikes you the most?*
- *How can this passage give you faith and courage to pray for people to be healed?*

Eyes of blind opened - John 9 (Also in Mark 8v22-26)

Ears of deaf unstopped -Mark 7v 31-37

Lame man leap like a deer- John 5 v 1-15, Mark 2v1-12

Get everyone to share what their favourite miracle of Jesus is and why?

Spend a few minutes being accountable with each other about how it is going praying for and sharing the gospel with the three people whose names you wrote down earlier in this series.

Finish this evening by praying for those who are sick in your life group, families, friends and communities.
