1 Corinthians 7:25 – 8:13

Undivided Devotion- 7:25-40

God calls us as Christians to be devoted to his purposes. In a world where our priorities get pulled from one direction to the next, we must be steadfast and unwavering in our service to the Lord with an urgency that reflects God's heart for the lost.

Knowledge vs Love 8:1-13

As Christians we value knowledge and recognise the importance of it in our lives. However, knowledge for the sake of knowledge only "puffs up", whereas love "builds up". It is necessary that as we grow in our knowledge of God and of each other, that the growth comes from a place of love, not pride.

Don't feel any pressure to do every area below with your life groups, pray about which points are most relevant to where your life group members are in their walk with Jesus.

Chris talked about Paul's urgency to see Christians live out the purposes of God with urgency.

Question 1

What does this look like on a day to day basis in your life and how does it affect the way that we share the gospel?

Question 2

Talk about and give examples of ways that knowledge that isn't applied in love could be hurtful and cause your brothers and sisters in Christ to stumble. Now talk about the opposite and how as Christians we can use knowledge to build and strengthen His Church.

Chris talked about how our priorities in life should be undivided and devoted to God

Question 3

With so many aspects of life to consider, how is this possible and talk about what it would look like in everyday life? Here are some examples- loving our neighbour, caring for our family and serving God with our finances?

Jenni talked being known by God and knowing God

Take some time to discuss what this means and why it's a vital part of our lives and His children- also you may want to compare the difference between what this knowledge would look like with love and without love.

Remind yourself of the promises of God, ask the Holy Spirit to fill you and help you to be devoted to Him in all areas of your life and to know and love Him more and more each day.
